The length of most answers will be at least a large paragraph. The only source should be the AP World History textbook. This assignment is due on the first day of school. Notebooks are available in room 5.

- 1. Discuss the Agricultural Revolution. How did agriculture spread?
- 2. Discuss the characteristics a society must have in order to be considered a "civilization".
- 3. Discuss how some civilizations developed complex societies and sophisticated cultural traditions.
- 4. Why are the Phoenicians important?
- 5. Discuss the Indo-European migrations.
- 6. Discuss the Bantu migrations.
- 7. Discuss the origins of the caste system.
- 8. How does Persia exhibit the characteristics of a centralized imperial state?
- 9. Discuss how the tenets of Zoroastrianism influenced later religions.
- 10. Discuss the different solutions that Confucianism, Daoism, and Legalism proposed to end the period of the Warring states in China.
- 11. The Qin dynasty was the shortest dynasty in Chinese history. Why is it also one of the most important?
- 12. Why did India have such a difficult time maintaining centralized authority?
- 13. Discuss the development of Hinduism and Buddhism in India.
- 14. How did Alexander the Great influence the development of the Mediterranean and Persian worlds?
- 15. Discuss the major Greek philosophies.
- 16. Your textbook discusses "religions of salvation". How are they important?
- 17. How does the small city-state of Rome come to dominate the entire Mediterranean world?
- 18. How does Rome transition from republic to empire?
- 19. The period from 27 BCE to 180 CE is known as the Pax Romana (Roman Peace). Discuss specific evidence of what this means.
- 20. The Silk Roads (land and sea) are very important in world history. Discuss how the Silk Roads influenced trade, the spread of religion, and the spread of disease.
- 21. Discuss the multiple reasons why the Roman Empire and the Han Empire fell.
- 22. The period from the late 500's to the 1200's is seen as a golden age in China (Sui, Tang and Song dynasties). Discuss the technological, economic, and religious aspects of this golden age.
- 23. Discuss the feudal system in medieval Japan.
- 24. Islam begins in the early 600's. Discuss the tenets, the split, the expansion of this religion and how trade was influenced by the Islamic empire.
- 25. How did Islam make inroads into India?
- 26. Discuss the Indian Ocean trade network. How did the monsoons affect trade and how was the caste system impacted by this?

- 27. How did India influence Southeast Asia?
- 28. How did the Byzantine Empire come about and what were its achievements?
- 29. Why were the Franks and the Vikings important?
- 30. Discuss the differences between eastern Europe and western Europe in the time period between 500 CE and 1000 CE.
- 31. Discuss the first split of Christianity which occurred in 1054 CE.
