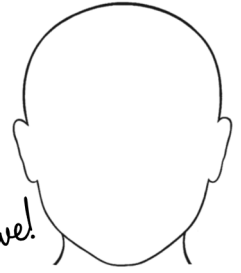

_____ Head is securely glued to reinforced backing. (construction paper, cardstock, or posterboard)

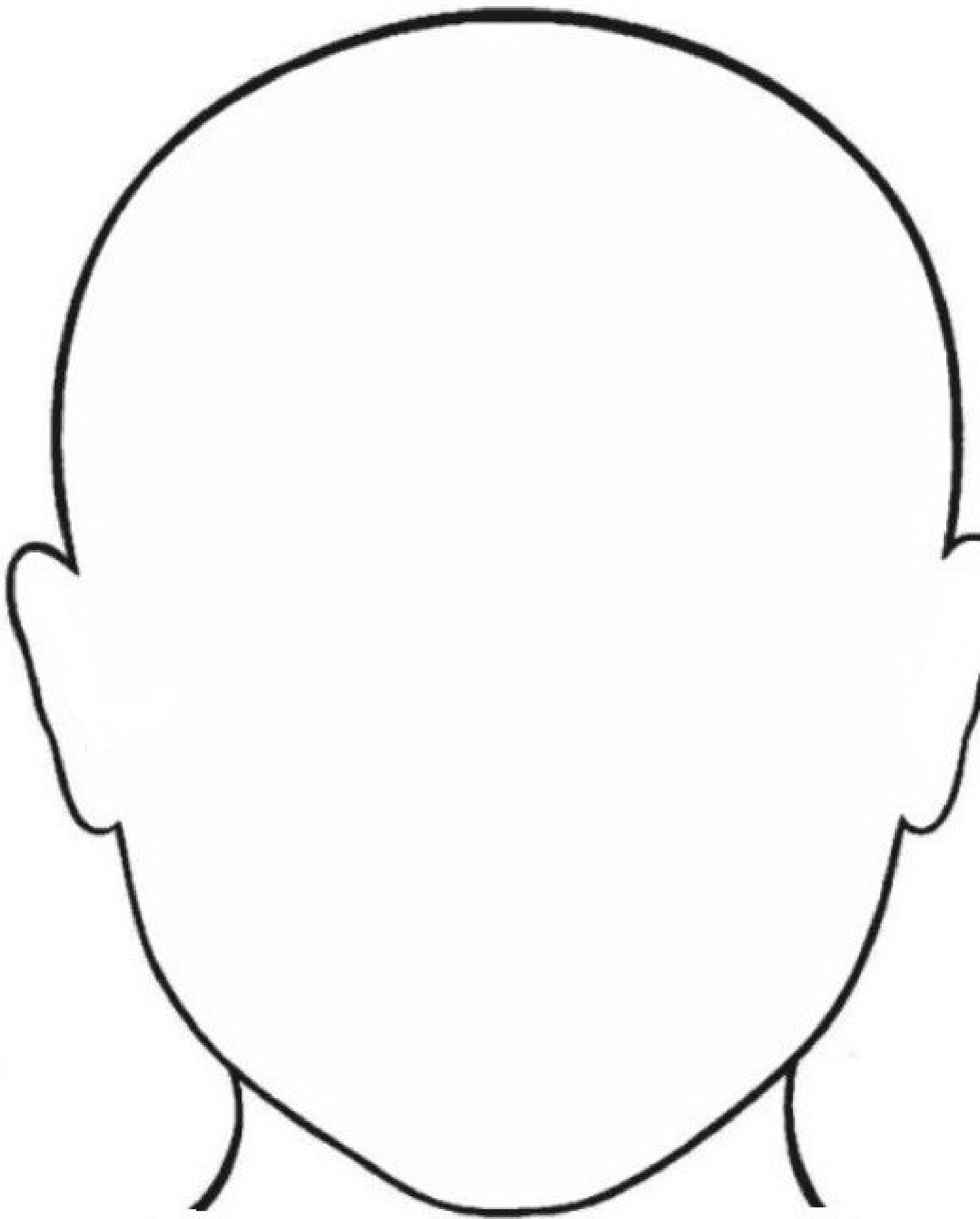

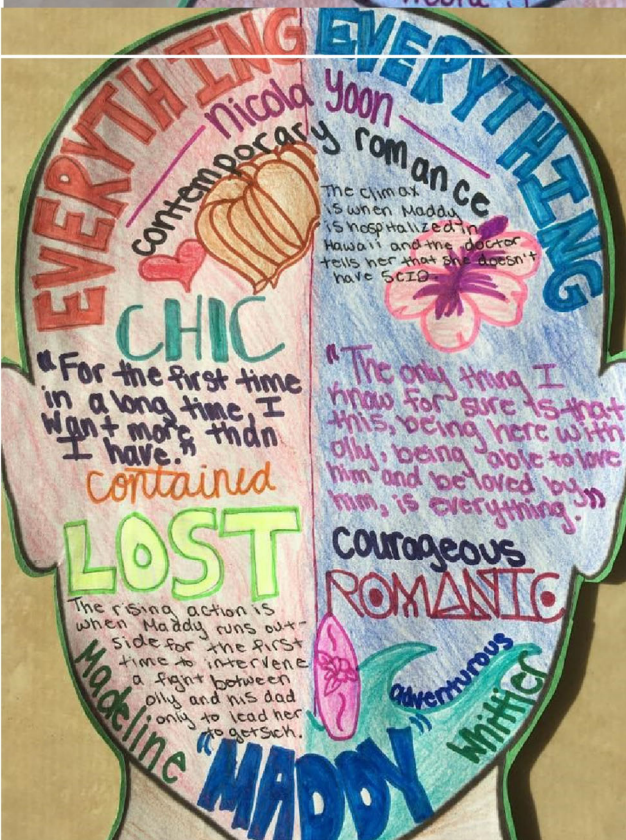
